2. Questions and answers per section

2.1 RFC-063-A20-TR4 - TS041 IC247A Refinement dispute process

1. What can and may the former SUP do if he does not agree with the new SUP overwriting the meter reading?

This question was not addressed in the information session because the contents of the RFC have not yet been approved by the Business Owner System Process Consultation (BOSO). Once the RFC has been approved, the contents will be explained in a different information session.

2.2 RFC-051-TS055 Number of malfunctions in notification

2. Is there also a maximum number of malfunction reports in the notification from TS055?

No, there is no upper limit to this number. This RFC can be used to add 0 or more malfunction reports per allocation point to the notification. As a result, DSOs can make all their registered malfunction reports available in the API, although it will often involve 0 or 1 malfunction reports per allocation point.

2.3 Test planning

3. **What if you have been unable to run the GAT scenarios within the test period, and qualification has been unsuccessful?**

In this case, the release will continue. However, parties will be able to consult Het Normo and the DSO about which support can be provided after the GAT.

The DSO will offer dedicated support during the qualification period, but it will be 'business as usual' after that, whereby priority and support will be scaled back. So a longer period of time may be needed.

4. **Will the request scenarios in the qualification plan for TS023 still be scrapped? They had been included in a previous draft but, following the RFC, I think they have to be removed.**

The request scenarios are no longer relevant to suppliers but *are* relevant to DSOs.

2.4 Qualification

5. **Question relating to TQF IC280L. Correlation IDs had to be supplied under TR3. Does this also apply to IC280L? The answer was not clear in the documentation.**

During the initial go live for Tranche 3, the Test and Qualification Facility (TQF) of TenneT did not yet support the automatic processing of qualification scenarios. Checks on the completion of qualification scenarios thus had to be done manually by TenneT, based on the Correlation IDs. This has been automated in the meantime and it is no longer necessary to supply the Correlation IDs.

6. **Is there a reason why the May release contains a TS055 requirement for SUPs and not for OSPs?**

This is because, when it comes to OSPs, the registered mandates must be accessed. This part of the mandate is responsible for the delay in the construction phase.

2.5 Milestones

7. **KGT SUP TS055 - 3 March appears to be missing from the list of milestones.**

This is only for a limited group. The milestones that we share in this information session are for the whole market.
